Since its creation in 2011, Portuguese festival, Semibreve, has built a formidable reputation for being one of the most exciting and forward-thinking yearly events on the international exploratory music and digital arts calendar. In its three editions, Semibreve has presented unique collaborations by some of the most revered electronic music artists from around the world. Including both new and established artists, Semibreve has commissioned performances by Ben Frost, Forest Swords, Vladislav Delay, Jon Hopkins, Mouse on Mars, Alva Noto, Fennesz, Emptyset, Ryoji Ikeda, The Haxan Cloak and many more, as well as presenting an informed programme of new work produced by students from Minho University in the digital art's field.

The perfect fusion of a carefully curated live programme, its stunning location spread across two auditoriums in one of Braga's most renowned and oldest theatres, Teatro Circo, and impressive audience numbers, has brought about well-deserved critical acclaim and support from the

likes of Pitchfork, The Wire Magazine, FACT, Clash Magazine and more recently Semibreve was named one of most exciting festivals in the world by Dazed and Confused Magazine.

The fourth edition of Festival Semibreve will take place in Braga, Portugal, from 10 to 12 of October, in the magnificent Teatro Circo.

Modern Love's occult duo Demdike Stare, Warp Record's visionary musician patten and Japanese recording and installation artist Ryoichi Kurokawa are the first confirmed acts for the concerts programme.
